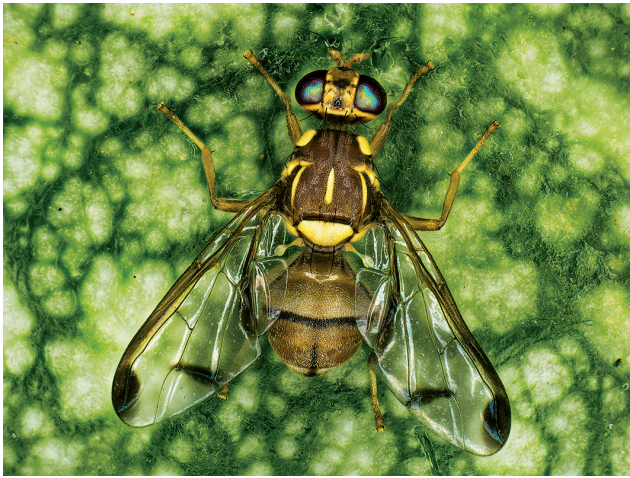




Zeugodacus cucurbitae (Coquillett)

Melon Fly



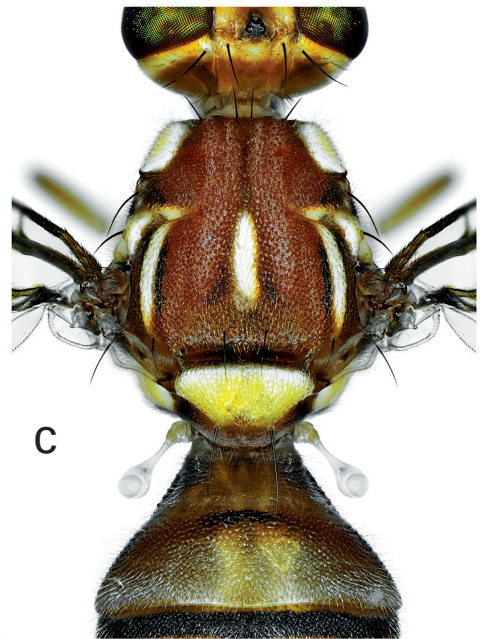

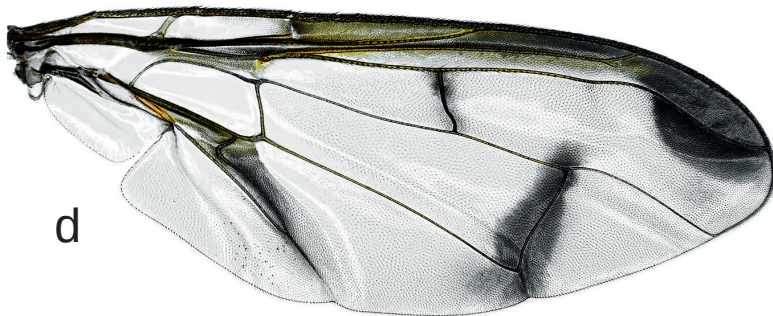
